HARDSHIP FUND POLICY

Hillingdon Triathletes (“the Club”) is committed to helping members and encourage wider participation in the Club, the Club sessions and Club events. The Club is prepared to help members during periods of hardship so that they can continue to train and enjoy the sport of triathlon.

The Club Treasurer will establish and operate a Hardship Fund for the sole purpose of assisting club members with:

- Membership fees
- Reduced rate swimming sessions
- Reduced race entries

The following rules apply:

- Have been a member of Hillingdon Triathletes for 24 months
- Have volunteered their time and shown commitment to help with past events over the last 6 months
- Can provide evidence they are currently suffering under financial hardship

The fund can be accessed by approaching any of the Treasurer, Chair or Secretary.

All cases dealing with the hardship fund will be dealt with confidentially and will be judged on its own individual merits. The Club will not set a precedence over any one action.

Cases will be reviewed every 6 months and the Club has the right to stop any agreements with members at any time they deem necessary.
